Sports Premium Impact Statement 2016-17

The Government has provided Sport Premium funding directly to schools– this money is ring-fenced to support the delivery of PE and Sport in Primary Schools.

At Cockton Hill Infants' School our Sport Premium allocation for **2016 – 2017** is £8,500.

We have used this money in the following ways:

Activity Leadership Apprenticeship	£5700	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• led playground activities during break and lunchtimes• whole school involved in Run-a-mile and total distance added up and reported to parents weekly on newsletter• all children in reception work in small groups delivering gross/fine motor skills – supports early handwriting development• children identified with movement difficulties are involved in specific motor skills interventions• supported the delivery of afterschool clubs eg. multiskills, hula hooping, streetdance.• more children active during Breakfast Club activities• worked alongside class teachers supporting groups of children in curriculum PE.
Youth Sport Trust membership	£580	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Developed skills and confidence in those staff who have embarked on this training and professional development.• Children have been involved in a wider range of inter-school festivals such as gymnastics, dance and table tennis.
Afterschool Activities	£2900	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continued links to local dance group Xtreme Dance Fusion, encouraging child to pursue physical activities outside of the school environment.• Different types of physical activity offered as afterschool clubs in order to appeal to a wider range of children
Staff Training	£1200	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Develop staff expertise when delivering curriculum PE.• Involvement of nursery staff in order to improve provision of physical activity and basic skills of very young children.• Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and Sport.

As illustrated above, the money allocated to the above activities demonstrates diverse use of the Sports Premium amount. We believe the impact of spending extra money in this way is very worthwhile and has had huge benefits to the pupils and the school community as a whole.
