Classes with best attendance: Class 3 – 99.3%

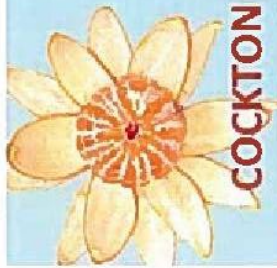
137 out of 165 pupils had 100% attendance that week! This is excellent – sticker for you all!
