## Sports Premium Impact Statement 2017-18

The Government has provided Sport Premium funding directly to schools– this money is ring-fenced to support the delivery of PE and Sport in Primary Schools.

At Cockton Hill Infants' School our Sport Premium allocation for 2017 – 2018 is £16000.

We have used this money in the following ways:

Develop role of Teaching Assistant with responsibility for: promoting more active playtimes across the school including the Daily Mile	£10500	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• led playground activities during break and lunchtimes</li> <li>• whole school involved in Run-a-mile and total distance added up and reported to parents weekly on newsletter</li> <li>• all children in reception work in small groups delivering gross/fine motor skills – supports early handwriting development</li> <li>• children identified with movement difficulties are involved in specific motor skills interventions</li> <li>• supported the delivery of afterschool clubs eg. multiskills, hula hooping, streetdance.</li> <li>• more children active during Breakfast Club activities</li> <li>• worked alongside class teachers supporting groups of children in curriculum PE.</li> </ul>

Staff Training and Resources; Occupational Therapy British Cycling	£3500	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop staff expertise to deliver "stabiliser-free" sessions as well as more advanced cycling skills.</li> <li>• Staff have increased confidence, knowledge and skills to deliver motor skills interventions.</li> </ul>

As illustrated above, the money allocated to the above activities demonstrates diverse use of the Sports Premium amount. We believe the impact of spending extra money in this way is very worthwhile and has had huge benefits to the pupils and the school community as a whole.

By upskilling staff within the school as well as employing outside coaches, we are ensuring that the improvements made are sustainable in the longer term.
